## COMMUNITY SUPPORT SOUGHT FOR ANNUAL DES PLAINES LETTER CARRIERS FOOD DRIVE

The Self-Help Closet & Pantry of Des Plaines and the Des Plaines branch of the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) are appealing to the community for assistance with the 19th annual NALC Food Drive on Saturday, May 14.

Every year at this time, residents and businesses are asked to leave nonperishable food items outside their door for local letter carriers and community volunteers to collect. **Des Plaines businesses that would like to participate can collect food for pick-up on Friday, May 13 during regular business hours.**

The food that is collected in Des Plaines benefits residents in need who are clients of the Self-Help Closet & Pantry of Des Plaines. Currently the Self-Help Closet & Pantry serves approximately 1,000 residents each month.

Volunteers are needed to sort food at the pantry, 600 E. Algonquin Rd., and to assist the letter carriers by canvassing neighborhoods by car and bringing food to the Des Plaines Post Office on May 14. The food is weighed at the Post Office and then transported to the food pantry.

Nearly 1,500 local NALC branches in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands are involved in the annual food drive.

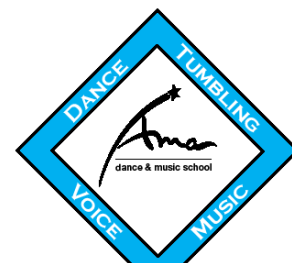

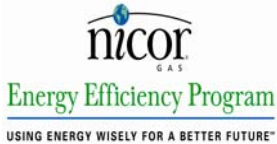

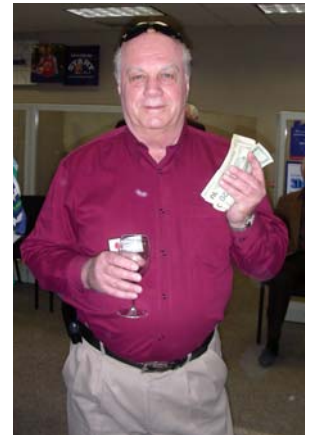
